### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current revision of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the current prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, by the rules of the United States Sunfish Class Association / International Laser Class Association / United States Optimist Dinghy Association / International Finn Class / except as any of those are change by the sailing instructions.

### 2 CHANGES TO THE RULES

The sailing instructions will change some of the racing rules; however, competitors will be able to comply with the changes without advance notice of their nature.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

**3.1** The Galloway Regatta is open to boats of the **Sunfish (with Jr. Class), Laser, Laser Radial, Finn, A-Cat, Open Bic, & Optimist Classes (R,W,B,&G)**. However, the Charles R. Galloway Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the top finisher in the Sunfish Class from a Gulf Yachting Association member club.

**3.2** Eligible boats must enter by completing the [official entry form](#) found on [www.gulfportyachtclub.org](http://www.gulfportyachtclub.org) by 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 - \$30 (August 14<sup>th</sup> or after \$40) - \$5 discount for USSA Members. Entry Fee includes: Sunday lunch on the water, drinks on the water, & free draft beer after racing. (Sunfish Class has no entry fee)
